Green:

Yellow:

Exclusive zones, often accompanied by a specific name or sign indicating reservation for a particular person or place. These areas are also commonly designated for taxis or commercial business.

Blue:

Exclusively reserved for individuals with an obvious or certified disability. It's important to note that these spots are not intended for pregnant women or older adults.

Red:

Signifies no stopping, standing, or parking whatsoever. It's crucial to adhere strictly to this regulation to maintain traffic flow and safety.
