

WASTE REMOVAL

RECYCLABLES

All recyclables must be rinsed clean. Dirty items may contaminate the whole batch - sending it all to the landfill. It assists our recycling contractor if you sort your recyclables into separate bags for plastic, paper, and aluminum/tin.

ALUMINUM – Clean aluminum foil, pans, beer and soft drink cans, and tin food cans. You can crush the cans to conserve space.

PLASTIC – Rinsed plastic containers, lids, and bottles, including water, soda, milk and juice bottles, yogurt and deli-type containers, shampoo, cleaning products, clear take-out clamshells, plastic cups, and take-out coffee lids. Please remove the lid from bottles (recycle separately) and flatten the container to conserve space.

PAPER – Clean paper and cardboard containers, including cereal boxes, cardboard packaging, and clean takeout containers like pizza boxes. TetraPak juice or milk containers, rinsed, flattened with plastic spout removed. Large, flattened cardboard boxes - if they are too large to fit, place them behind the bin.

GLASS – Rinsed glass beverage bottles (liquor, wine, beer, tonic) should be placed in the nearest glass deposit. There is one at approximately every other waste enclosure.

NO Styrofoam, plastic wrap, plastic shopping and produce bags, plastic packaging, cellophane. No "wiping" paper such as napkins, paper towels, or tissues. No soiled or greasy cardboard.

ORGANIC WASTE

Unfortunately, we do not have a viable process for handling compostable organic materials at this time. Please bag your organic waste, seal tightly, and deposit in the trash container.

TRASH

Everything not listed as Recyclable should go in the Trash container which goes to the landfill. Please bag your garbage, especially organic waste.

GLASS

Liquor, wine, beer & tonic/mixer bottles – take to your nearest glass repository Botellas de licor, vino, cerveza – lleve al depósito de vidrio más cercano
